The Indiana Nursery and Landscape Association has developed the Indiana Accredited Horticulturist Program to provide a method of self-study and accreditation for individuals in the green industry.

The goal of this program, begun in 1975, is to develop knowledgeable, motivated, and professional employees for the landscape and nursery industry.

The IAH study material is now available by clicking on or copying and pasting the following link: hort.purdue.edu/iah/. If you decide to become certified, you must register and pay the enrollment fee using the application in this brochure or by using the online application at <https://inla1.org/iah-certification/>.

The online study material consists of basic information on plant growth and development, plant maintenance, and pest control. Additional information covers turf establishment and maintenance, landscape plans and specifications, and soils characteristics. All chapters having been authored by college professors from Purdue and other universities.

After studying the IAH Training Manual, the individual will be eligible to take the examination to determine the level of mastery of the study materials. A certificate and Indiana Accredited Horticulturist logo patch will be presented to those professional individuals who achieve a grade of 80 percent or more.

An individual who passes the exam is recognized in the *Indiana Nursery and Landscape News* as an Indiana Accredited Horticulturist.

The IAH study material also serves as a useful reference for insect and disease questions, turf establishment, plant maintenance, and proper pesticide handling practices.

This program involves the further investigation of the IAH study material and passing an essay and plant identification exam with a grade of 90 percent.
